

**SPECIAL CALLED MEETING OF THE LLANO CITY COUNCIL
JULY 9, 2007**

CALL TO ORDER – Mayor Roger Pinckney called the meeting to order at 12:00 noon with the following council members present: Bubba Bollier, Cheryl Crabtree, Shane Gray, Bryant Ratliff and Eddie Stefan

DISCUSSION/ACTION

1. Discuss and consider wastewater treatment plant. Mayor Roger Pinckney asked for public comments on the wastewater treatment plant. A motion was made by Councilwoman Cheryl Crabtree and seconded by Councilman Eddie Stefan to take no action on the vehicle allowance for the Police Chief and City Manager at this time. This motion passed by a unanimous vote.
