CALL TO ORDER – Mayor Mike Reagor called the meeting to order with the following council members present: J.R. Decker, Tom Dalrymple, Mike Hazel and Gordon Hefner. LaNell McKinney was absent.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Discuss and consider approval of Special Called City Council Meeting Minutes of January 14, 2010, Regular Called City Council Meeting Minutes of January 19, and Special Called City Council Meeting Minutes of January 21, 2010.
A motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Mike Hazel and seconded by Councilman Tom Dalrymple to approve the Special Called City Council Meeting Minutes of January 14, 2010, Regular Called City Council Meeting Minutes of January 19, and Special Called City Council Meeting Minutes of January 21, 2010. This motion passed by a unanimous vote.
2. Discussion only - contractor lawn disposal fees. City Manager Finley deGraffenried advised council that staff would prepare an ordinance and bring it to Council at a future meeting.
3. Discuss and consider Resolution 2010-02-01 authorizing Mayor to execute conveyance documents for alley closure in Block 16, Davis Addition, between California Street and Oregon Street. A motion was made by Councilman J.R. Decker and seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Mike Hazel to approve Resolution 2010-02-01. This motion passed by a unanimous vote.
4. Discuss and consider Park Permit for Crawfish Open. A motion was made by Councilman Tom Dalrymple and seconded by Councilman J.R. Decker to approve the Park Permit for Crawfish Open. This motion passed by unanimous vote.
5. Discussion only – Utility metering and remote reading. Councilman Tom Dalrymple commented that he felt it would be advisable for Staff to prepare a Request for Quotation for replacing only the water meters in light of the expense of the quote for utility metering and remote reading.
6. Discussion only – New proposed FEMA Floodplain Map. City Manager Finley deGraffenried advised Council that the new flood map indicates the same flow as the 1935 flood. Mr. deGraffenried advised that staff is waiting for meeting date confirmation for a town hall meeting.

The regular session recessed at 5:56 p.m. and the Llano City Council convened into executive session.


Update on Legend Oaks Lift Station – Regarding resolution of lift station issues. City Attorney Cary Bovey is reviewing the Lift Station

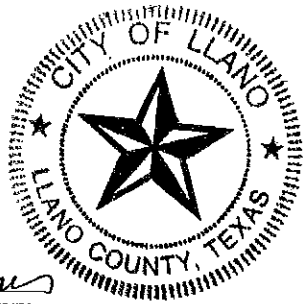
