

ORDINANCE NO. 1157

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS. AMENDING
SECTION 38-9. MUNICIPAL COURT CLERK
CITY OF LLANO MUNICIPAL CODE PROVIDING THAT IN THE ABSENCE OF A
CITY COUNCIL APPOINTED MUNICIPAL COURT CLERK, THE CITY
SECRETARY SHALL BE EX OFFICIO CLERK OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT AND
SHALL PERFORM SUCH DUTIES AS MAY BE REQUIRED BY LAW AND
ORDINANCE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LLANO:

SECTION 1. Amend Section 38-9. City of Llano Municipal Code by the addition of the following:

In the absence of a City Council appointed Municipal Court Clerk, the City Secretary shall be the ex-officio Clerk of the Municipal Court and shall perform such duties as may be required by law and ordinance.


SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this ordinance is held invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other provisions of this ordinance, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

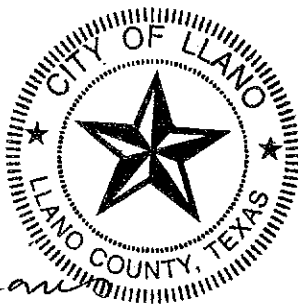
SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
